

Using Power-Link and Power-Merge Products with Windows 2000

We have found that neither Power-Link nor Power-Merge are adversely affected by their use under Windows NT or Windows 2000. In fact the available memory is typically better than Windows 9X or ME.

SCREEN TIP : It is sometimes observed in Windows 2000 that the window created to run the program seems to distort the programs true appearance and thus will not show the bottom are of the screen. This is particularly frustrating as the help prompts are located in this area.

To fix this problem, right click on the short cut used to start the program. Go into the PROPERTIES and select the tab (found across the top) caled "Layout", there you will find Screen Buffer Size where the Height may be set to 300. For proper screening of Power-Link set this to 25 and press OK.
